 - A. It feels good. *Psalm 37:4*

 - B. It honors God.

3. How can you tell if a woman fears the Lord?
 - A. She is not anxious about the future. *Proverbs 31:25; 14:26; 31:21*

 - B. She has practical wisdom. *Proverbs 31:26; 9:10*

 - C. She is strong. *Proverbs 31:25; 31:17; 23:17*

 - D. She does not live for herself alone but for others, especially her husband, if she is married. *Proverbs 31:11-12; 31:23; 12:4; 31:20*

 - E. She lives for the good of the needy.
